Tools Needed:

- 10mm, 7/16" Socket and Ratchet - 5/16" Drill Bit

- Pliers - Dremel or Oscillating Multi-Tool

Needle Nose Pliers - Marker
 Flat Blade Screwdriver - Drill

Boss Grille Installation

1. Open hood.

- 2. Remove four 10mm bolts from the top of the grille and set aside for reinstallation.
- 3. Remove one push clip from the air deflector on the driver side near the headlight.
- 4. Carefully unclip five retainer clips that are behind the grille near the bottom. Use a flat head screw driver to release the retainer clips.


<u>CAUTION:</u> Take the proper precautions to protect the face of the grille from cosmetic damage.



- 5. Reposition factory grille away from the vehicle and place on a clean non-abrasive workbench.
- 6. Review Figure 1, 2, and 3 before cutting your factory grille. You will need to remove the center chrome or painted sections of the factory grille.
- 7. Carefully cut out the center section of the factory grille. Use the dashed lines in Figure 1 as a guide for cutting. (Note: Discard the center section of the factory grille.



8. Break off 18 tabs located on the rear of the factory grille. Locations shown in Figure 2




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9. Turn grille back to the front side and remove the outer most C-shape plastic parts. Verify grille shell looks like Figure 3. (Note: Breaking the tabs in Step 8 allows these front pieces to be removed. Rear plastic will remain)



10. Position and align the **BOSS Grille** inside the factory surround. Mark the mounting locations using the brackets on the back side of the grille with a marker. **BOSS Grille** in grille shell will look like Figure 4.

(Note: Ensure that the grille is centered and aligned before drilling.)

- 11. Remove **BOSS Grille** from the factory surround and drill eight holes using a 5/16" drill bit. Use the marks made in Step-10 as a guide for drilling.
- 12. Insert the **BOSS Grille** into the factory surround. Align the mounting tabs with the drilled holes.
- 13. Secure the grille to the factory surround using the hardware provided.
- 14. Verify that the grille is secure in the factory surround and tighten all of the hardware.

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For Lighted grilles, refer to Wiring Installation on Light Bar Installation Instructions for wiring instruction.

- 15. Attach the grille to the front of the vehicle by aligning the five retainer clips that attach near the bumper and press inwards. (Note: A loud clicking noise is normal.)
- 16. Verify that the grille retainer clips are fully engaged and that the grille is secure.
- 17. Re-attach the four 10mm bolts that were removed in Step-2 and tighten down.
- 18. Re-attach the air deflector that was detached in Step-3.
- 19. Close hood and confirm that all components and hardware are tight and secure.

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
